

Subsidized Passes for Low Income (SPLIT) Program

February 11, 2025



Program Overview

- The SPLIT program assists seniors, adults and students living with a low income in Halton by subsidizing the cost of a monthly bus pass or ticket strips in Burlington, Milton and Oakville, and taxi scrip or Activan in Halton Hills.
- The program is administered in partnership with the Burlington, Oakville, Milton transit companies and the Town of Halton Hills.
- The Regional staff assess financial eligibility using the gross Low Income Cut Off plus 15%.
- Ontario Works and ODSP clients automatically qualify.
- Local transit companies issue passes and tickets at their transit terminals.

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants must be a resident of Halton, legally entitled to reside in Canada.
- Tourists, visitors, sponsored immigrants and international students are not eligible for the program.
- Applicants must provide proof of address, income and immigration status to verify eligibility.
